CURRICULUM NEWS

Reception The children have been learning about doubling. They have been doubling numbers from 1-7!



Year 2 have been learning about features of defensive castles across the UK, alongside ac-



tions to help us remember them. By the end of the week, the children will have labelled the different castles we have been learning about onto a map of the UK. We are looking forward to our trip to the Tower of London on Tuesday 16th April.

Year 4 We looked at how tsunamis work by building our own tsunami models to start our unit about natural disasters. We reproduced and observed the brutal effect these large waves can have on land. But

we also learnt (and tested) a way to protect the coast and control the damage tsunamis cause! Come and ask us!



Year 5 Willow Class have been learning about Shakepeare's work. The role played the first three acts of Macbeth.



Year 6 We have been exploring the historical West African kingdom of the Benin, located in present day Nigeria.
